

Electric Pallet Jack

Used Pallet Jacks Vancouver - Industrial pallet jacks simplify tasks and allow workers to transport wood pallets of various weights within warehouse settings. The unit is steered with a lever which also acts as a pump handle to raise the jack. The forks can be lowered to the ground via a small handle that is located on the tiller. This handle releases hydraulic fluid when it is activated. The front wheels are found inside the fork ends mounted on levers. These levers attach to linkages connecting levers which are united with the jack cylinder. The hydraulic jack raises at the end with this system as the links force the wheels down. The forks vertically raise above the jacks' front wheels to lift the load up past the floor and for safety reasons, loads are only raised to clear the floor. Typically, pallet jacks have steering wheels located in the front and each fork often comes with a single or double wheel configuration.
